**SANDY CREEK
NYS BOAT LAUNCH
ROUTE 3, PULASKI NY**

This is a relaxing paddle in a quiet stream for two miles to the sandy beaches of Lake Ontario. We will lunch on the beach and then head back after a gathering of friends. Bring beach chairs for your comfort, or a beach blanket. The put-in on NYS Route 3 and is a Fishing Access Site. It is very nice, with good parking. It also has a Porta-Potti and picnic tables.

Directions: Plan on arriving by 11:00 AM and expect a 2+ hour ride from Rochester to get there. The put-in on NYS Route 3 is marked by a NYS Sign “**South Sandy Creek – Access Site.**”

There are a couple of alternative routes to this location as follows:

1. NYS Thruway Eastbound to 81 North to the Pulaski (Rt 13 Exit). Head East on Rt 13 to NYS Rt 3 (right turn) and then proceed 11.3 miles to the access site.
2. Scenic Route along the lake. NYS Rt 104 East to 104B to NYS Rt 3. On Rt 3 at Pulaski where NYS RT13 merges you will then proceed another 11.3 miles on Rt 3 to the put-in.

Once again, Sue and I will welcome members of Chapter One to our home on Canandaigua Lake on Saturday, August 25th any time after 1 PM. Plan for a fun afternoon by (or in) the water. Activities available include: canoeing (duh!), kayaking (related), swimming (there's a raft 100' from the dock), laying about in the sun (OK, we need a prayer here), and camaraderie with fellow canoeists, while enjoying frothy adult beverages from the garage fridge (there's also water, iced tea, pop, etc.).

If the water's too rough for canoeing, we can offer boat tours of (part of) Canandaigua Lake. If you're up for a bumpier and moist (OK wet) tour, we can always drop the Sea Doo in the lake for a little exercise. For sailing enthusiasts, you can try your hand at sailing your canoe (or ours) with the sailing rig designed and fabricated by Pam Wedd of Bearwood Canoes.

We will provide beverages and meat for the grill, which will be fired up

around 5 to 5:30 PM. Guests can bring a dish to pass (hors d'oeuvre, salad or desert).

Check with Sue (755-2903 or 396-1492) to coordinate what's needed so we don't wind up with 2 hors d'oeuvres, 1 salad and 12 deserts. OK, some of you may think that's a *good* distribution, but you get the idea. You may also want to bring your favorite folding chair (or use one of our non-folding chairs), a towel, visor/hat, sun screen or other sundry items to help you enjoy an afternoon at the lake.

For those of you who have not been here before, the address is 3495 Lakeview Lane, Canandaigua 14424. From Rochester:

Take Route 332 south (from Exit 44) to and through downtown Canandaigua. The traffic signal by the Sunoco Station is Parrish St. Turn right on to Parrish St.

Travel about 4/10 mile west to the first traffic light. That's West Lake Rd. (Co Rd 16)

Turn left on to West Lake Rd and go 1.4 miles south to Lakeview Lane. Left on to Lakeview Lane. Park in our driveway or the elongated strip of grass along the west side of Lakeview Lane that all of us (on the street) use for guest parking.

Not Coming From Rochester:

Find Canandaigua on a map and drive there. Find Main St. which is north/south through the center of town and also known as Route 332

Find the Sunoco Station and follow the directions above.
